



# Shortlist for the UK Picture Editors Guild Awards in association with Shutterstock

After weeks of deliberation we are finally able to present the shortlist of the UK Picture Editors Guild Awards.

Hundreds of photographers submitted thousands of pictures that were judged by ten experienced judges.

The number of pictures submitted this year was in excess of four thousand images. The previous record was 2,700 this year the total number entered was 4,300.

Helen Healy, Head of Pictures at the FT and chair of the judges said “There was a very strong set of entries for this year’s Picture Editors Guild Awards. I was particularly impressed with the Photo Essay category. The photos covered a huge range of news stories from 2018: big events such as the migrant crisis, Brexit, climate change to essays about Irish dancing and World War II veterans. It was very difficult to narrow down my top favourites.”

She continued “The Canon Sports Photographer of the year was another excellent field with difficult choices to be made as was the Fixation News Photographer of the year where many of the key moments from last year in news were captured”

Derek Momodu of the Daily Mirror said “Throughout the judging process, I looked for aestheticism, relevance and, more importantly, originality. There has been a wealth of talent in this year's competition Congratulations to all the winners. Every entry, professional or otherwise, is commendable.”

The awards will take place at the Honourable Artillery Company headquarters in City Road, London, on Monday March 25<sup>th</sup>
